BACKGROUND

The BOSTON ABCS is a standardized criterion-referenced test that includes seven domains.

METHODS

Inter-rater reliability was collected during the administration of the test by having five observers score each item of the test simultaneously.

RESULTS

DOMAINS	AGREEMENT
1. Executive Functioning	87.5%
2. Verbal	98.81%
3. Visual Spatial/ Fine Motor	96.36%
4. Social/Leisure	100%
5. Reading	98.54%
6. Writing	88.2%
7. Math	95.35%

CONCLUSION

The Inter-rater agreement between observers for the entire test was:

94.99%

IMPLICATIONS

The BOSTON ABCS is a reliable instrument that can be used to track progress over time.
